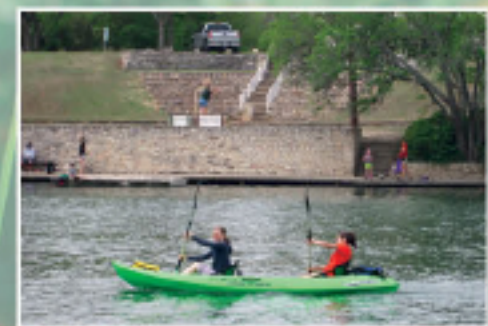

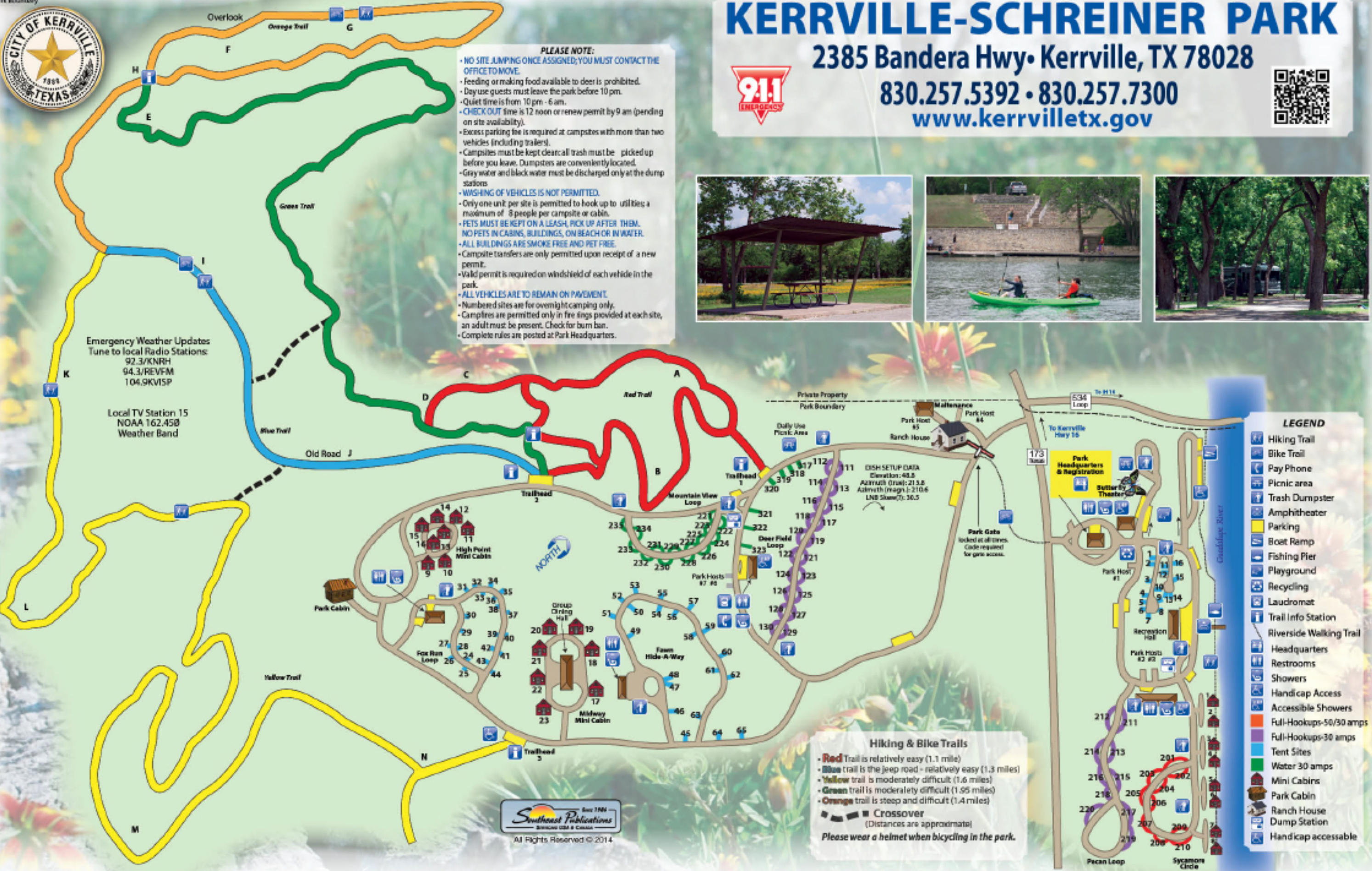


- PLEASE NOTE:**
- NO SITE JUMPING ONCE ASSIGNED; YOU MUST CONTACT THE OFFICE TO MOVE.
 - Feeding or making food available to deer is prohibited.
 - Day use guests must leave the park before 10 pm.
 - Quiet time is from 10 pm - 6 am.
 - CHECK OUT time is 12 noon or renew permit by 9 am (pending on site availability).
 - Excess parking fee is required at campsites with more than two vehicles (including trailers).
 - Campsites must be kept clear all trash must be picked up before you leave. Dumpsters are conveniently located.
 - Gray water and black water must be discharged only at the dump stations.
 - WASHING OF VEHICLES IS NOT PERMITTED.
 - Only one unit per site is permitted to hook up to utilities; a maximum of 8 people per campsite or cabin.
 - PETS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEASH, PICK UP AFTER THEM. NO PETS IN CABINS, BUILDINGS, ON BEACH OR IN WATER.
 - ALL BUILDINGS ARE SMOKE FREE AND PET FREE.
 - Campsite transfers are only permitted upon receipt of a new permit.
 - Valid permit is required on windshield of each vehicle in the park.
 - ALL VEHICLES ARE TO REMAIN ON PAVEMENT.
 - Numbered sites are for overnight camping only.
 - Campfires are permitted only in fire rings provided at each site, an adult must be present. Check for burn ban.
 - Complete rules are posted at Park Headquarters.

- Orange trail is steep and difficult (1.4 miles)
